Description

This database contains various poor law records for London. Poor law generally refers to poor individuals such as the elderly, orphaned, unemployed, or sick and afflicted. These individuals were eligible to receive help such as monetary relief and other daily necessities such as food, clothing, and work. Children could be appointed to apprenticeships or placed in schools and other institutions.
