Anne was probably the daughter of
Ole Bjørnsen Gresli Vestre (Jensgården) (c.1665 - c.1631) and
Maren Jensdatter.

According to "Tydalsboka", volume 2, page 282 and "Bygdebok for Tydal", volume 4, page 158, the brothers Sakse and Anders each married a daughter to an Ole Jonsen at Kirkvold.

The aforementioned Ole Jonsen has not been found as a user at Kirkvold. I suspect that it is all an after-construction based on the fact that both Sakse and Anders were married to Olsdøtre and that a Jon used Kirkvold in 1723 and 1727.

Anne married Sakse Henningen in his second marriage. Sakse was the son of Henning Jakobsen who took over Kirkvold around 1712.
