Anno Christi 1692. & Richarde Scott of King Standly in  
the County of Gloucester. ~~the County~~ Baker being sick  
and weak in body, but of good wchst. & sound memory in  
thankes be to God do make, and ordaine this my last will &  
last Will and Testament in manner and forme following  
(That it to say) I impriue & bequeath my soule into the hands  
of God my heavenly Father: having through his Mirth, death  
and passion of Jesus Christ my alone, and blessed saviour  
obtaine faire pardoun & forgiuenesse of all my sinnes, and inherite  
everlasting life. And my body I committ to the Earth to be  
decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter  
named, And as touching my temporall Estates, of godes, and  
disease thereof at followeth. Item first I will that my a  
Debt, and fundrall Expenditour be paid and discharged. Item  
I give, and bequeath to my Eldest daughter Mary my bel  
body. Item I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Edith  
all that parte of the dwelling house which I now liue in, and  
the orchard adjoyning, and belonging to the same. To helpe  
unto her the said Edith for and during the tyme of her  
widow hood, or naturall life; And after her marriage  
or death, I give the same house & my selfe to my Eldest son  
Richarde to helpe to him for & during all the residue and remain  
der of herme. & estate then to come, and ensgage her. Item I  
give, and bequeath that my forement, (at the South end of  
my said dwelling house, betweene Richarde & Elizy) doe now dwelle  
And all that pasture ground and the garden therunto a  
adjoyning, and belonging, called by the name of the grove  
by god, unto my said wife. To helpe to her for the tyme of  
her naturall life: upon condition that she shall seeke to the  
bringynge of my children here, under named: And after the  
decease of the said Edith my loving wife: I give and bequeath  
all the last mentioned forement, pasture ground, and garden  
unto, and amengest all my nine chilren. That is to say,  
to Mary, William, Hannah, Chester, Daniell, & foorth, Catharine  
John, and Edith for and during the remainder of the tyme  
that shall be then to come & none other. Item All the rest &  
residue of my goods, and chattells, I give and bequeath  
unto my said wife Edith. I whom of god make, and ordaine  
unto my said wife Edith of this my last will, and testament. And  
for witness of this my last will, and testament, all former wills, and testa  
ments heretofore made, by me had or made. In witness where  
of the said Richarde Scott to this my last will & testament  
have subscribed my name, with my owne hand, and set to my  
seal. This day and yare first above written.
