

In the name of God Amen; The thirtieth daie of October in the thre & thirtieth yere

in the Countie of Berke yoman beinge sick in bedde, but thanke be geven to god in yitt
memorie, doe make and ordeyne this my last will & testament in maner & forme followinge
viz. first & foremost I bequeythe my soule to hande of almightie god, my saluacion & redemcion
I shew Christ, and I beleeue to be saved by the merittes of his passion, wch was shed for me
and all good christen people, and I will my bodie to be buried in open buriall that is in the
Church of Westmynster, Item I geve to the mother church of Saye in Berke Item I geve
to the church of Westmynster in Berke Item I geve to the poore people of the Towne of
Westmynster to be distributed by the discretions of my overseers, Item I geve
to the poore of the Tithings of Westslokinge, & yitt to be likewise distributed by my overseers,
Item I geve to Alice Endreles my wyf. Ten poundes of current money to be paid to her
that month after my decess, Item I geve to John Endreles my eldest sonne, ten poundes
to be payed him att his age of one & twentieth yeres. Item I geve Robert Endreles my
second sonne ten poundes of current money to be paid him att his age of one & twentieth yeres
Item I geve to Jane Endreles my daughter, ten poundes of like current money to be
paid to her att the daie of her marriage or att his age of one & twentieth yeres, wch shall first
happen; Item wher as my said wyf shal geve the said Child, if the said Child be borne
Alive, & doe well and prosper, then my will is, the said Child shall have ten poundes of like
current money, if itt be a man child then he to have the said ten poundes att his age of one
and twentieth yeres; other wise, if it be a daughter to be paid att the said age of her marriage
or els att the age of one & twentieth yeres wch shall first happen, Item it is my will, if
any my said Children doe decess before their said age or marriage aforesaid, then
theire legacies to her or him gyven shall remayne to be equally divided, amongst the
restant of my children survivinge to be paid to them att the times aforesaid Item I geve
to John Endreles my eldest sonne my first acre of land wch I bought of Mr William Widdow
& Robert Wyddonam; Item I geve to Alice my wyf, the use & profit & occupation of my
said first acre of freeland soe longt & untill my sonne John Endreles shall accomplish
his age of one & twentieth yeres; Item I geve to every one of my godchildren & wyfs;
Item my will is that my executors shall bringe upp my said Children in good &
Christian & education untill their said age or marriage, The residue of all & inght
my goode & chattels moveable & unmoveable; furrall, dette & legacies contented &
satisfied & payed I geve to Katherine Endreles my mother & to John Endreles my
brother, & Michaell Endreles my brother in lawe, whom I make & ordeyne to be my full
& whole executors of this my last will & testament, and I desire & make enscue of this my
will to be itt pformed my wellbelovyd frende & brother in lawe William Calbott and
Robert Loder & I geve to every of them for their paynt takinge five shillinge A
pccet witnessed unto this will Edward Bratt Ensan Calbott Alice Johnson Elizabeth
Lyceman & others
