Frank J. Doherty is writing an opus called "The Settlers of the Beekman Patent", currently in it's eleventh volume (covers the names Rood to Sly). But way back in the seventh volume, there's a chapter on the Johnson surname. It runs from page 230 to page 291.

The

Beekman Patent is shown on the following map. It was a major patent held by Henry Beekman, granted in 1697. The red outline is Dutchess County; the blue squiggle is the Hudson River; the yellow area is the Great Nine Partners Patent, highlighted for a different article.

The Patent is

occupied by today's Towns of Beekman, Dover, Pawling, Unionvalle, and half of LaGrange. However, there is bleed-over between the people of the Beekman Patent and those of other nearby Towns.

Doherty identified at least three Johnson families in the Beekman Patent area in the 18th Century:

- 1. Descendants of Pieter Jansen of Norway, the earliest arrival.
- ¥2. Descendants of John Johnson of England, a captain.
- 3. Descendants of Edward Johnson of England, another captain.

In addition, Doherty found 30 pages of Johnson entries from all over New York that he could not place within these three families.

[Doherty

consulted many excellent primary and secondary sources, but also inexplicably threw in some data from online message boards and the like. Read those footnotes to differentiate!
