Recieved a cow and steer and utensils from the estate of her father Matthew Clesson in 1716. A history of North Brookfield Worchester Co. MA tells of a 1693 Indian attack on the early residents of "Quabaug", the original name of Brookfield . The attack resulted in the deaths of several residents including Joseph Mason and his son and the capture of teenager Daniel Lawrence and "the wife and infant child of Joseph Mason. The infant was killed the first night out." The Massachusetts Archives retains the letters of Major John PYNCHEON, who was in charge of the party that pursued the Indians and recovered the two captives.
