LONG: - Joseph Long, Dorchester, 1660, son of Mary, the widow of Joseph Farnsworth, by wife Mary, whose surname is not known, married 1662, he had Mary, and died 1676. His widow married Thomas Litchfield, from whom she was divorced and died about 1703. The daughter, Mary, married Henry Straight, of Greenwich. R. I.

Thomas "Leichfeild," freerrian in Dorchester, 1679. Had wife, Mary, from whom he was divorced (?), before 1690, in which year she married, 3d, John Hooper, in Boston. Her first husband (who died in Aug 1676) was Joseph Long, son of Joseph and Mary (Lane) Long (see Lane Gen.). She had one daughter, Mary Long, who married Henry Straight, of East Greenwich, R. I., before 1693. (See Boston and Suffolk County records.) Dorchester records give birth of a daughter of Thomas L., born Aug. 18, 1678. Her name was Anne.
