 Exeoutor in one Years time after my Decese Item I give and

bequeath unto my Son in law Charles Sanckford the Sum of one
Shilling to be paid by my Executor in one year time
Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Chirrol the
Sum of one Shilling to be paid by my Executor in one year
time after my Decease Item I give and bequeath to my well
beloved Son in law Ralph Wakling whom I likewise constitute
and make and ordain my only and Sole Executor of this my last
Will and Testament all my Bills Bonds Ready Money Chables and
all things appertaining to me by him freely to be possessed and en-
joyed and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every
other and former Testaments Wills and Legacies Bequests and Executors
by me any waye before this time made Willed and Bequeathed
and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament
