of lirk money All which Leges is are to be paid at the age of one and
Twenty years or age All the residue of my Goodes Chattells
triffls and household stuff my debts and Legacies being paid and
my funerall expences discharged I give and bequeath unto my son-
in-law ffrancis Gamon and to his now wife Mary Gamon to whom
I make my sole excoutors of this my Last will and Testament
