KNOW all Men by these Presents, That we John Groper of
Liverpool Minor of that Majesty of Houghton
both in & County of Lancaster

are bound and firmly bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God
James by Divine permission Lord Bishop of Chester
in the Sum of Twenty Pounds of good and lawful Money of Great-
Britain, to be paid unto the said Right Reverend Father his lawful Attor-
ney, Executors, Administrators or Assignes, To which payment well and
truly to be made, we bind our selves and ~~either~~ of us severally for
and in the whole, our Heirs Executors and Administrators, and the
Heirs Executors and Administrators of ~~either~~ of us jointly by these
Presents, Sealed with our Seals and dated the ~~ante~~ Day of
July - - in the 13th Year of the Reign
of our Sovereign Lord George 3d King of Great Britain,
France and Ireland, Defender of the Faith, and in the Year of our Lord
God, Our thousand seven hundred and forty -

THE Condition of this Obligation is such, That if there be not any
Impediment of Precontract, Consanguinity, Affinity, or other lawful
Cause to hinder the Marriage of John Groper & Mary Long
both of Liverpool

or any Controversy or Suit depending in any Court before any Ecclesi-
astical Judge, touching any Contract or Marriage of either of the said Par-
ties with any other; and if the said Parties have obtained their own discre-
et Consent of their Parents if they be Living, or otherwise of their Guar-
dians or Governors, and shall celebrate the said Marriage in the Parish Church
of Houghton

according to the Letters of Dispensation to them in that behalf granted. And
finally shall at all times hereafter save and keep harmless the above-named
Lord Bishop his ~~Successors~~
and his Surrogates, and all other his Officers for and concerning the granting
of the said Letters: Then this present Obligation to be void, or else to remain
effectual in the Law.
