The condition of this obligation is such that if ever for the reason not
 appear any cause let or impediment by reason of any consanguinity affinity
 or contract of matrimony or any other cause whatsoever but if the
 abovesaid William Warburton may lawfully marrye take to
 wife Mary Smyth - - offesday - in the County aforesaid
 pmo - And yet at this present time he do not any suit
 plaint querrel or demand moved or depending in any either
 civil or in ill behalf either of the parties any other person
 or persons whatsoever for or concerning any matrimony contract
 or alledge to be contracted consumpt either of the parties any
 other person or persons whatsoever And if he said who do not
 the abovesaid of this marriage is by law force free from fault of
 their parents and Godmothers of the said children and of the
 persons of the said marriage is by law force free from fault of
 the Church of Halton Holgate or St. Mary at Chappell in the
 City of Lincoln and elsewhere by a lawful minister without
 hours of night had up by the Church of the said of the day
 according to the form of the book of Common prayer
 lastly if he said abovesaid at this now present charge
 do not hinder or defend by any manner of proceedings
 he abovesaid the said of the said of the said of the said
 their officers Ministers or all persons for all things touching
 pmo in any respect then this obligation is in full force
 effect as to the said in full force and virtue
