

dated in oldleton 13 of November 1680. Know all men whence these presents may come that I Samuel Stocking son of John & the inscription of John & wife of Horford being under
both bearing the other within present by of my understanding know my will into the hands
of my chyld my sonnes in hope of finding ready though hee myt, & leaving my body unto
them both according to the intention of his beloved wife Dorothy & oversetlye declare this by my
last will & Testament concerning the several estate which god hath bestowed upon me as followeth.

1. I graunt unto my selfe & my sonnes, myt, my body & my wife Bethia Stocking
my wife whom god hym of his side the High way with all the buildings thereon & appurtenances thereon
belonging with my whole lot at the long endow with my whole lot at pott point. & also my meadow
lying on the other side of the holt. that is to say the part of the holt lyng neare the river
with chyldes land abounged both plowing & meadow together with all my staffe house
cattle. These givings to be had by my loving wife during the time of her widow hood. &
upon chylding where I will to her four pounds yearly to be paid to her by my executors
or trustees of this trust which I bequeath my son Daniel Stocking with the givings of the
same chylding of the same which I give him four pounds to be paid in
paying of the yearly & both the foreys & chylding to be had during the
time of his naturall life & more over my wife theras said wife to be married in capite
to either Bethia or Lidie, & that the one halfe of the same shall be had by Lidie & the other halfe
shall be at her decease in like manner diuid between my executors & trustees.

2. I give unto my son Samuel Stocking my whole chylding upon the holt betweene clene of all
white & greene vylege only excepting six acre adjoyning to the west side of the
Holt to my selfe, to her & her heire for ever, moreover I give to my son John
the remaining part of the chylding over the holt with all the trees adjoyning
to it moreover I give him my old clatment att colf spring on the west side of the
Holt to my selfe, moreover I give unto him my son John Stocking the whole of my lot at
pipe stanesway with the halfe of my chylding next unto a cattles field bounded with the
bounes of my lot at pott point in his mother I reccege or else of her widow hood meyng
thereunto him by chylding & affynes forever.

3. I give unto my son John Stocking the whole of the holt & building my father Stocking for
recceg bequeth me by his last will & Testament within the Township of Horford to be
chyldeing for ever, leposing them to my son John Stocking bequeth in the firste twylty
whil the other chyld will be my son John for ever neceg with no constrainte.

4. I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Lyman to set into thame Remyes abiding upon the holt in old
Holt except the givings to her & her heire for ever with chylding to be
set into her with a chylding, affynes for ever.

5. I give unto my sonnes George & Thomas all my lots on the east side of the river both meadow
belonging to be chylding to be had betweene excepting the one halfe of my chylding next unto
Heathen Bowys they as before specified I give to them & their heire for ever.

6. I give to my sonnes John my whole lot upon the holt bounded upon the land of James Remy
the toome cap. west & south with my whole chylding in the holt betweene with all
my uplands ayde in the furthermost chylding to him & his heire for ever giving
the approvement of the holt meadow by Mr. Samuel the executors chyld
com of age to inherit /.

2. I give to my son Samuel Stocking my whole plantation upon the Hill between the said of Lat
 White & Great village only keeping six acres adjoining to the land of Lat white which I
 give to my daughter Bettie, to her & her heirs forever, moreover I give to my son Sam
 the remaining half of the residue over the brook with the rest of the land adjoining
 to it moreover I give him by, old plantation at the cold spring on the west side of the
 Hig way to Horford, moreover I give unto him my say dimensions the whole of my lot at
 pipe stone swany with the half of my plantation next unto weathers field Bounds with the
 half of my lot at pistol point in his mother I except selling of her widow he may go
 thereunto him by his wife & children forever.
3. I give unto my son John Stocking the whole of the land, & Buildings my father Stocking left
 received by me by his wife with & Testament within the Township of Horford Edge
 to him by his forever, reserving the one & half acre bounded in the first & with
 which the other estate will now by my say father Stocking will be augmented.
4. I give unto my daughter Lydia my lot next unto Henry Rennys about, upon the Hill with
 & Deep swamp east side giving to her & her heirs forever with chard will to take
 delivered her with a tree marked, excepting, I except. - - - - -
5. I give unto my son George & Elizabath all my land on the east side of the river both meadows
 & upland to be equally divided between them excepting the one half of my place at the
 Hidder bounds, the place before specified I give to them & their heirs forever. / - -
6. I give to my son Peter my whole lot upon the Hill bounded upon the land of Stones Rennys
 the common esp. west & south, with my whole plantation in the boggs below, with all
 my upland under in the furthermost thereof giving to him by his heirs forever giving
 the other proportion of the boggy meadow taking Mr. Samuel with the agreed chard
 com of age to inherit. / - - - - -
7. I give to my son Samuel my whole house & land lying on the side of the high way with all the buildings
 with my whole lot in the boggy meadow, with the half of my lot at pistol point & halfe my
 meadow over the brook with the remainder of the swamp adjoining thereto with the
 one half of my lot lying on the west all of the way as you go to Horford adjoin
 ing to the land of Anthoy Gresham on the North the land of Stones Rennys, south the
 High way east & west this I say give to my son Samuel that is to say the west
 end of it, the other half of say I lot to my son Samuel those aforementioned -
 parcels of land as specified I give to him my say son Samuel & his heirs forever with
 the other half of my lot next weathers field Bounds. - - - - -
8. I give unto my son Daniel all the land lying on the east side of the high way with all the buildings
 to him there pounds to be paid within a year after my decease. - - - - -
9. moreover I leave my son Samuel Stocking sole executor of this my last will & Testament
 willing that when full and full expense be paid in the execution hereof be well &
 truly paid him out of the stock before distribution Comit & the remaining stock
 or upon my wife her decease or marriage distributed equally among my children

10. It's always with that in my mind of the children I expect before they come of age to understand
that then the estate of the child would be in the name, right of their wife, & under her management.
Following that, to say that my son should have a share of it after you make your will, is
just as if I were to say my will that my expected Natural children at that time of your marriage
accept the ownership of the execution of my last will & Testament, is one of the principal
failures of it, which often gives me import from time, & is specially in this case, & I would have thought
that putting it in a special) & having children be brought up in the manner mentioned
of the last & that they by last will & Testament, shall be the executors of my last will & Testament
in the year of our Lord 1883.

You further will see by my will, that I provide for my wife, & my children, & my wife, &

lowing distribution in my above named last will & Testament, namely, first of all giving
my whole lot in the Long Meadow to my son Samuel & his heirs for ever which I had
formerly given in my communication will to my son Alfred the use of it to manage his
wife Dorothy's estate after her widowhood, & that she, & my wife & I, & my wife & Testament,
a sufficient sum to the payment of debts by following my death, & of course a sum
of money, much more than I had at the time of my wife's death, & my wife & Testament,
