

For as much as my time is uncertaine: and I know not the day of my  
Death: I Account it my duty: to make my last will and Testament, which is as  
followeth: I Resigne and give up my selfe, soule and body: to my Soueraigne  
Lord and maker: my god and father in my Lord and saviour Iesus Christ: and to  
prevent trouble to those that shall suruiue me, I Doe Dispose of that portion of  
outward Estate, which the Lord hath in mercy blessed me with: in manner  
following

I Item I give to my Louing Brother John Stockin six Acres of my homelott  
next to the widdon millocks: and my lott on the west of the plaine  
and my lott at pipestaue swamp: and the one halfe of my land  
at the Island

I Item I give to my Brother George Stockin: the one halfe of my wet meadow  
and swamp and my lott in the long meadow and my lott at side hill  
and halfe my land at the Island

I Item I give to my Brother Daniell Stockin: my meadow land and swamp  
ouer the brake: and my part of that lott beyond John warricks

I Item I give to my Louing sister Bethia Stone: my house and the Remainder  
of my land not already disposed of: and the one halfe of my wet meadow  
and swamp

I Item I give to my Louing sister Lidia Howell my house lott: which I bought  
of good wife Kirby: with all the buildings yppone it  
farther my minde is that After Just debts are paide and funerall Charges  
the Remainder of my stock and moucables lie Equally diuided Amongue  
my Breathren and sisters

This is the last will and Testament of Samuel Stockin of Middleton  
taken from his owne mouth: and read to him: and he did declare  
him selfe well sattsified: in what disposall he had made of his Estate  
December the first 1697
