Notes for GEORGE A. FERRINGER:

"All living Ferringers today are descended from this man. He was the only male to survive and reproduce a fourth generation. Sometime after the death of his father in 1777, when George was only 6 years old, the widow Clara and two surviving children returned to the Rehersburg area. This is the same area where George's grandparents, Debald Theobald had originally settled...

George and his wife would have 5 children while living near Rehersburg, and all were baptized in the Altalaha Lutheran Church. Sometime between the birth and baptism of Peter, in July 1798, and the birth of Christine in September 1800, George moved his family to an area near the western border of what is today Dulphin and Schuylkill Counties. This area is in the western end of the beautiful Hegins Valley...

George Ferringer, his wife and children were well respected as citizens and farmers..."(1)
