

NEPP/NAVE

Leonard NEPP/XAYE (1766-1844), native of PA, was about 10 yrs. old when his father George died. His mother recurred & he left home at an early age. In Somerset Co., PA Leonard married Margaret MILLER (1769-1819). In 1793 they moved to Kentucky, near Boonesboro. He was a compatriot of Daniel BOONE--found shelter in the same fort with him during an Indian raid. He shared fully in the dangers & trials of Indians & the War of 1812. Children: John; Dr. Peter; Eva HOOVER; Michael; Elizabeth WOODWARD; Catherine HEISTAND; Jonathan; Susannah O'BRIAN; Joseph and Margaret DICKERSON.

Michael NEPP/XAYE (1794-1851) was a farmer & a blacksmith. In 1815 he went to Montgomery Co., OH where he married Esther WEAVER (1798-1826) on 22 Mar. 1817. She was dau/of Peter & Elizabeth (HEISTAND) WEAVER. Michael lived in Jefferson Twp. on the Peter WEAVER farm, then purchased 160 acres in Perry Twp. from his father-in-law. Children: Abram; Michael (went to TX); Elizabeth BREIDLINE & Margaret who d/y.

Married/2 Barbara STORY, dau/of Joseph STORY. Children: Eva, Jonathan & Aaron who d/y.

Married/1 Mrs. Lydia STORY. Their children: Sarah ELIZABETH & George (died in Civil War).

Politically Michael NEPP was a Whig. He was unswervingly honest. He died on 10 July 1851 at Charleston, W VA on the way to Sulphur Springs, W VA where he was going to try to regain his health.

Abraham NEPP (1810-1906) married 1840 TRACY "Tracy" WILLIAMS, dau/of Ariel & Margaret (TOLBY) WILLIAMS. Tracy (1817-1888) was born in OH. Abraham, a blacksmith was big and rugged. He was a member of the Old School Baptist Church. He was Township trustee for 10 years and a member of school board for 17 years. Abraham & Tracy lived 4 years on an 80 acre farm near Defiance, OH, then returned to the NEPP homestead. Children: John (died b 1860); Miranda ARNOLD b 1846; Allen b 1851; Mary BOWMAN b 1860; Margaret Ann "Maggie" DUNKINGER b 1850; Nelson b 1856; Adelia LANDIS & Althen (died) Jessie "Peter" b 1857; Nettie Catherine PILDRICK b 1859 & Minnie A. (died) b 1861. All of Abraham's children were tall and big except for Maggie.

Allen NEPP (1847-1913) married Mary BREIDER (1851-1937) dau/of Tobias & (WILDAIR) BREIDER. Children: Lydia CARVER; Orpha (LUCY) Abraham; Bertha (died); Tobias "Mike"; John Calvin; Lewis Henry & Rufus Allen. Allen & raised their family on a farm in Franklin Twp. He was a farmer and an Order Preacher. He was hit on the head by an axe & lost his usefulness in his time. He slowly went blind. He died at the home of his oldest son Lydia CARVER at Peru, IN where he had gone to visit. He is buried at Peru Cemetery.
