In the <u>Potts Family Records</u> Leonard Nave is described as having light hair and blue eyes. His religion was given as "nominal" and Margaret's as Baptist. He was buried "near Nicholasville" and she was buried in "old churchyerd".

In his German prayer book (present location unknown) the name was spelled Maeff. The names listed in it were

(Margerat Nava Dickerson claimed to be the youngest of elsven children and she had elsven.)

Leonard Nave and Setsy Sowing were issued a marriage license December 17, 1823 (Jessamine Co. Marr. 8k.1, p.70). "Patsey" Bowing (on marriage certificate) was married to Leonard Nave on Dacember 26, 1823 by Moses Hoover. Parhaps they did not remain together. Leonard did not give consent to the marriage of his daughter Margaret. The consent was signed by Elizabeth Nave in Mercer Co., Ky. in 1828. Elizabeth was born about 1778 in Virginia. In 1850 Elizabeth Nave 72 was living with Paulina Bourne 41 Va. and Harriagn Bourne 22 Ky.

(It must be noted that the information given about the parents; of Leonard in the <u>History of Kentucky</u> by Perrine, Battle, and Kniffen, 1887 (pp.823-4) is somewhat erroneous, the writer having connected the hentucky family to the wrong Michael Neff. We find no records for Leonard in Juniata Co., Pa., a county not formed until 1831.)

From information in the 1810 census, available birthdates, and marriages, we have worked out the following for the children.
