

In the Potts Family Records Leonard Nave is described as having light hair and blue eyes. His religion was given as "nominal" and Margaret's as Baptist. He was buried "near Nicholasville" and she was buried in "old churchyard".

In his German prayer book (present location unknown) the name was spelled Naeff. The names listed in it were

(Margaret Nave Dickerson claimed to be the youngest of eleven children and she had eleven.)

Leonard Nave and Betsey Bowing were issued a marriage license December 17, 1823 (Jessamine Co. Marr. Bk.1, p.70). "Patsy" Bowing (on marriage certificate) was married to Leonard Nave on December 26, 1823 by Moses Hoover. Perhaps they did not remain together. Leonard did not give consent to the marriage of his daughter Margaret. The consent was signed by Elizabeth Nave in Mercer Co., Ky. in 1828. Elizabeth was born about 1778 in Virginia. In 1850 Elizabeth Nave 72 was living with Paulina Bourne 41 Va. and Harrison Bourne 22 Ky.

(It must be noted that the information given about the parentage of Leonard in the History of Kentucky by Perrine, Battle, and Kniffen, 1887 (pp.823-4) is somewhat erroneous, the writer having connected the Kentucky family to the wrong Michael Neff. We find no records for Leonard in Juniata Co., Pa., a county not formed until 1831.)

From information in the 1810 census, available birthdates, and marriages, we have worked out the following for the children.
