

LEAVES 90 DESCENDANTS

Aged Dickinson County Woman Survived by Scores of Kinfolk.

Abilene, May 28.—Mrs. Marie Page, widow of the late Samuel Page, departed this life at her home in Hayes township, aged 86 years. Funeral services were held from the Bethel church near Moonlight Tuesday afternoon and was attended by many relatives and friends. The remains were laid to rest in the cemetery near the church.

The deceased was a daughter of Jacob and Esther Shuh and was born in 1822. With her parents she moved to Dauphin county, Pa., in 1834, at which place she was married to Samuel Page of the same county, January 20, 1842. Mr. Page died July 15, 1906. They came to this county in 1858, where they have since resided.

To this union were born twelve children. Forty-six grandchildren and thirty-two great-grandchildren, and of these ninety descendants, forty-one grandchildren and twenty-eight great-grandchildren survive. The children living are: Mrs. Sarah Conrad, Melbourne, Ia.; Anna and Michael, who reside at the old home; Isaac, Mrs. J. H. Bert, Mrs. D. H. Bert, Joseph H., and William of this county; and a son-in-law, John R. Noll of Ramona, Kan.
