and I fort my Do by this my last will & Testament
 giving my house in London in the parish of St. Martin in the
 field where it shall please God to call me home ...
 I give I bequeath my precious mortal soul into the hands
 of our Heavenly Father and my body to be at
 the disposal of a glorious beheading
 and as for my worldly goods the love due be bestowed
 upon me of my friends & relations as follows
 I give I bequeath by deed of gift & disposal of my
 Company and estate unto my children my will is and
 I do hereby give and bequeath one third part of all
 my moveables unto my beloved wife Mary
 Item my will is that the other two thirds of all my
 moveables be equally divided unto each of my children
 alike quantities
 Item my will is and I do hereby give I bequeath & appoint
 my beloved sons I give I bequeath Joseph with his
 & natural & small Executors of this my last will
 & Testament in full execution of the premises I have
 hereunto subscribed and affixed my Seal this
 twenty first day of January in the second year of
 the reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the third
 & in the fifth year of our said Lord King George the third
 King of Great Britain France and Ireland
 King of Denmark and in the year of our Lord one
 thousand six hundred and ninety one I have
 subscribed - O Sign of & Dated by the testator
 above mentioned in presence of us witnesses John
 O'Connor, John Woodroffe - 25th Feb. 1790
 John Lane his brother as Eliza present out John as
 O'Connor & John Woodroffe and bearing in witness
 according to Saint Germain that they have the above
 contents of the last will & Testament of the testator
 above signed & witnessed in his last will & Testament and
 that at the time he was of sound mind
