Appurtenances by Auction and for the best
Price or Prices that can or may be got
for the same and the Money arising by
such Sale I Give and Bequeath to and
amongst my Grandchildren, the Children
of my ^{late} Son, Charles and Roger Cholton and
the Children of my late Daughter Dinah
