weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God
therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament That is to say principally and first of all
I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and
for my body I recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian
like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doub-
ting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the mighty Power of God. And as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith
it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the
same in manner and form following Vizt —

→ Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son Henry Den-
drickson the plantation whereon I dwell and all the land belonging to the
same to him and his Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Bartholomew Cherington my part
the Tithes of land called Jamaica to him and his heirs forever.

I have given and bequeath unto my Son Matthias Hundertson a parcel of
Land called Marions park containing one hundred and thirty acres to him
and his Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Hendrickson a
parcel of land lying between Thomas Davis and John Lee being the middle
most Hundred of a parcel of land called this well to her & her heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Margarett Hendrichsen a parcel of land called Marksgården otherwise known by the name of Maria point to her and her heirs forever.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Hendrick for a free
of Land known by the name of Henry and Ward to her & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Plimber a parcel of Land called Couches Oversight to her and her Heirs forever and as to my Household Goods and moveables after all my Debts and funeral Charges are paid to be equally Divided among my aforesaid Children
Lastly I do constitute make and ordain my Son John Plimber my
