WHEREAS <u>William Townsend</u> of Solebury in the County of Bucks & Province of Pennsylvania, Son of Stephen Townsend of the same place And <u>Margaret Paxson</u> junr., Daughter of James Paxson heretofore of the same place deceased having declared their Intentions of Marriage with each other before several Monthly Meetings of the People called Quakers at Buckingham according to the good order used amongst them and having Consent of Parents & Relations concerned their said Proposals of Marriage were allowed by the said Meeting -

NOW these are to certifie all whom it may concern that for the full Accomplishment of their said Intentions this 22d Day of ye 6th Month in the Year of our Lord $\underline{1763}$ they the said William Townsend & Margaret Paxson appeared in a publick Meeting of the said People at Buckingham aforesaid – etc.
