 William Button of the Fountain County in the  
 State of Indiana do make and publish this my last  
 will and Testament hereby revoking and making void  
 former wills by me at any time heretofore made  
 to such worldly estate as it has pleased God to  
 trust me with I dispose of the same in the following  
 manner. (to wit) I give and bequeath unto William &  
 with my two Sons and also Mary my daughter who  
 live with me and have agreed to support and maintain  
 the minor heirs of Jesse my youngest son and also to take  
 care of and support me the remainder of life & therefore  
 devise and bequeath unto my three children above named  
 the south west quarter of section 30 in T 20 and range 7

also the east half of the South east quarter of Section 30 T2s  
 and range 7 also all the goods and chattels with the house  
 - hold furniture not otherwise disposed of. Second I give  
 and bequeath unto my son Ruben and my daughter  
 Elizabeth Gammon Peckham and the heirs of Jesse  
 Button, this following described tracts of land, the  
 West quarter of Section 18 in T. 19 of range 7<sup>th</sup>. also  
 50 acres on the north end of the west half of the South  
 east quarter of Section 18 in T. 19 and range 7<sup>th</sup>. and  
 also the South west 1/4 of the South west quarter of Sec  
 28 in T. 19 N. of range 7<sup>th</sup>. also the east half of the N.W.  
 quarter of Section 35 in T. 20. N. of range 8<sup>th</sup> that also the  
 N.W. quarter of the South west quarter of Section 28 in  
 T. 27 N. of range 7<sup>th</sup>. that also the South west 1/4 of the N.W.  
 West quarter of Section 20 in Township 27 of range 11 was  
 with all and singular the rents issues and profits  
 of the foregoing described lots of land to be equally  
 divided between the last mentioned five heirs  
 Lastly, I do hereby appoint my two sons William  
 & Jesse Button to be sole Executors of this my  
 last will and Testament revoking and annulling  
 all former wills by me made ratifying and con-
