 right of dower in a certain tract or parcel
 of land containing two hundred and four
 Acres lying in Culpeper County (Virginia)

 to have and to hold the said bargain
 premises to him the said Thomas Button
 his heirs and assigns forever. And the said

 and in consideration themselves and their
 heirs Covenant to and with the said Thomas
 Button his heirs or assigns that they do
 forever relinquish their right of dower
 in the aforesaid mentioned tract of land
 to him the said Thomas Button his heirs
 &c and do forever warrant and defend
 the same from them and their heirs
 and all persons claiming by, through
