

Elijah Elys deed from William Harrison.

KNOW all men by these Presents that I William Harrison of Woodstock in the County of Windsor and State of Vermont, for and in Consideration of the sum of four pounds Law full money to me in hand paid by Elijah Ely of Lyme in the County of New London and State of Connecticut & known the Receipt thereof have Given, Granted, Bargained, Sold, Released, Ratified and Conveyed unto him the said Elijah Ely all my Right Title or Share of the Estate of the Widow Sarah Tiffney of Lyme aforesaid dec'd. by Virtue of my being an Heir to that Estate, to have and to hold the above said Granted and Bargained Share right and Title with all the Privileges & Appurtenances thereunto belonging to him the said Elijah Ely his Heirs and Assigns for ever to his own their own proper Use & behoof forever, in witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 25th day of September 1790.
