

In y^e Name of God Amen I William Harvey being growne to a considerable age through y^e patience of God, & now being sick & weake in Body though of sound memory & judgem^t. blessed be God Do make & Constitute this my last Will & Testam^t. I doe Comitt my soule to y^e Lord Iesus Christ my Redemer in hopes of acceptance thro^{gh} free Grace & my Body to be Decently buried by my Exec^{utors} in hopes of a joyfull Resurrection through Christ our Lord. — Secondly to my son Thomas Harvey I give y^e house & Land he lives upon from y^e River up to y^e Highway, & another parcell at y^e higher end of my Land that runneth home to Joseph Willis's Land bounded ag^t my other lands by a small white Oake by y^e side next y^e Cart path & on y^e Swampe side by a Tree & yes along & so home to Joseph Willis his Land Also to Thomas I give threescore Acres of Land lying by Three mile River Bridge Also a Lott of Meadow at Seaddins should be about four Acres, Also one halfe of my late fifty-Acre Devision lying Easterly from y^e three mile River, All s^d parcells of Land to be to my son s^r Thomas Harvey & his heires & Assignes for ever. — Thirdly to my son Jonathan the Remainder of this my home-Lott at Towne with y^e house thereon & Barne to Jonathan also all my Land upland & Meadow lying up by Three mile River on y^e Easterly side thereof, & a small parcell of Meadow lying by Winnicummitt ponds, a small quantity of Meadow lying at y^e Brooke called Runford Brooke with all my share of Land if it called y^e North-purchase Also to Jonathan y^e other halfe of my late fifty-Acre Devision. — Fourthly to y^e Children of my son Joseph Harvey Deceased a parcell of Land lying at a place called y^e Streights being about eight Acres more or lesse & another parcell of Land being about nine Acres more or lesse lying neare a place call^d y^e Wolfe pitt Swampe the s^d parcells to be equally divided among the Children of my s^r son Joseph Also the meadow at y^e west side of three mile River to y^e s^r Children of my son Joseph. — Fifthly to Nathan I share jun^r I give a parcell of Land about or three Acres lying at y^e Norwest from y^e Meadow whith wee usually mow at three mile River. — Sixthly my Common Rights & all future Devisions to be to my two sons Thomas & Jonathan to be equally between them. — Seventhly all y^e rest of my moveable estate I leave unto my son Jonathan whom I doe hereby Constitute y^e sole Execut^{or} of this my last Will & Testam^t. who is to receive any Debts due to me & to pay what is due from me in Witnesse hereof I y^e s^r William Harvey have hereunto sett my hand & Seal this twelfth Day of June sixteen hundred Ninety one

I Thomas Flarney Son of Taunton in the County of Dorset in Newgate
 doire to the effect of William Flarney and Jonathan Flarney Both Dorset
 Doe agree and consent to it with John Hathway and Samuel Blakes
 Both of Taunton Dorset Guardians to the Children of Joseph Flarney Dorset
 which is as followeth vizt that my Sister in law Hester Flarney shall have and
 enjoy the New Dwelling House she hath in Taunton her widowhood and
 halfe the improved land on the North Side of the way beyond the Crook in
 Taunton in the field of said Flarney during her widowhood. And she to have the
 Orchard during her widowhood And her New Children by Joseph Flarney both
 the said orchard afterwards for ever And further the said Thomas Flarney doth
 Promise to pay at the Death or marriage of said widow the value of his Brother
 Joseph part (unto the Children of said Joseph) of the house said widow now
 dwelleth in, And to deliver to said Children all the Land & meadow given them in
 will of William Flarney Dorset and to their heirs for ever. And Likewise the said
 Thomas Flarney shall pay to said Children at they shall come to age three pounds each
 if one or more by before that time the Sumner or Surdiner shall have the Sum of
 three pounds Equivalent to money In Consideration whereof the above said
 Hathway and Blakes Doe acquitt & discharge as Guardians the above said Thomas
 Flarney from all Debt & Demands from the widow and her Children in or to the
 said Joseph Flarney and Jonathan Flarney for the true performance of the premises
 we the above said persons have herunto sett our hands Sealed the 18 Day of November
 1671 one thousand six hundred ninety one

An Agreement made November 19th 1671 Between Thomas Harbey son of Tuntorn
 in the County of Bristol on y^e one party. and Nathaniel Thayer & Thomas Harbey Jun^r
 on the other party in the behalfe of his now wife is as followeth viz:
 There having been a difference Concerning the Estate of William Harbey and
 Jonathan Harbey Deceased: Said Thomas Harbey son being here in law to both
 those Estates. The said Thomas Harbey both hereby Covenant and Promise to pay
 to said Nathaniel Thayer in the behalfe of his now wife between this date and the
 last day in March next after the date hereof the sum of Eighteen pounds in land &
 money private & valued by indifferent men. Indifferently chosen and given already
 Appointed. And to Thomas Harbey Jun^r in the behalfe of his now wife Eighteen pounds
 in all respects y^e time as the Eighteen pounds above mentioned. Upon which payment
 the said Nathaniel Thayer & Thomas Harbey Jun^r Do hereby Covenant & promise for them
 selves and theirs Respectively. absolutely to discharge & Acquit the said Thomas Harbey son
 his heirs and Assignes for ever of all Claims and Demands whole or in part to the Estate of W^m
 Harbey and Jonathan Harbey above said As witness each parties hands and seals on y^e
 last day of this present Agreement: with this further Addition before the sealing
 hereof. That said Thomas Harbey Jun^r Doth hereby promise upon the payment of the Eighteen
 pounds within mentioned that his now wife Experiencia Harbey shall seal & Deliver a dis-
 charge in full to said Thomas Harbey Jun^r according to the true intent of the within: In like
 manner the said Nathaniel Thayer shall seal & Deliver to said Thomas Harbey Jun^r a discharge
 in full upon the payment to him of Eighteen pounds within mentioned in the behalfe
 of his now Children
