Maryland Wills & Probates, 1635-1797

I Thomas Parsons of Anne Arundell County in y^e Province of Maryland being sick of body but of
perfect disposition moving thanks be to God doe make constitute Ordain & appoint this to be my last
Will & Testament recouching annulling utterly making void all other Will or Wills & Testaments to be
taken advised & held for my last Will & Testament as a last in manner & forme following. In witness
whereof I bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Parsons one shilling. I give & bequeath unto my daughter
Isabella Parsons fifty acres of Land y^e is lying upon Anthony Hollands & Benjamin both of the same
for her to have with her day of marriage for to be hers & her heirs for ever. I give y^e P. Isabella Parsons
should die without any issue of her body then this Land is to fall to y^e two youngest. I give & bequeath
unto my daughter Mary Parsons & Susan Parsons my plantation which I live upon & all things belong-
ing thereunto. I give it unto them to be equally divided between them after their Mothers decease
to be theirs & their heirs for ever. And if they two should die without any issue of their bodies then this
plantation is to fall to y^e two youngest to be theirs & their heirs for ever. I give unto my daughter
Sarah & Manna Parsons between them. I give a two year old heifer named Mealy. I give it between
them for it & its increase to be equally divided between them & to be theirs & their heirs for ever. And
likewise I give unto them my two daughters to each of them y^e first two Cattle y^e my mare being
let live in her will in mare Cattle for to be theirs & their heirs for ever. And further I do
hereby constitute & Ordain & appoint my loving friends Anthony Holland & Benjamin both of the same
whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament & for y^e Humphreys & Sherrish I have here set
my hand & state this tenth day of October in y^e year of o^r L^d 1683.
