## James Franklin Jernigan

James Franklin Jernigan was born on December 15, 1886 in Coffee County, Tennessee, the son of Jasper Newton Jernigan (1863-1928) and Amanda (Bynum) Jernigan (1857-1941).

A veteran of World War I, he was a fireman at Nashville Terminals and lived at 2211 28th Avenue South, Nashville. He was 56 years old and the husband of Eudora (Giles) Jernigan when he died in Nashville of a coronary thrombosis "on [the] train" on October 21, 1943. Burial was two days later in Mount Olivet Cemetery, Nashville.
