 This Indenture made this eighth day of June in the
 Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Six. Between Daniel Marsh
 of the Parish of Richmond in the County of Carlisle and Province of New Brunswick
 Farmer of the one part, and James Marsh of the Parish County and Province aforesaid
 Yeoman of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Daniel Marsh for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Six hundred Dollars of lawful money of New Brunswick
 to him in hand well and truly paid at or before the executing and delivering of
 these presents by the said James Marsh the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released conveyed and confirmed, and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell, alien release convey and confirm unto the said
 James Marsh his Heirs and Assigns. All that certain Tract piece or Parcel of Land and
 Premises situate lying and being in the Parish of Richmond County and Province
 aforesaid bounded as follows on the South by lands of Daniel Marsh Versa on the West
 by lands occupied by Patrick Kirkles North to a certain Brook east by the said
 Brook until it reaches the swamp thence South along the Swamp until it strikes
 the said Daniel Marsh Versa's East line making the Swamp the dividing line
 between said Land and Lands owned by Bradford Versa containing forty five
 Acres more or less said Land having formerly been deeded by Elijah Marsh to the
 said Daniel Marsh - Together with all Houses Out Houses Barns Buildings
 Edifices Fences Improvements Profits Privileges and appurtenances to the
 same belonging or in any manner appertaining, and the revenues and
 revenues, remainders and remainders unto issues and profits thereof and also
 all the Rights, Rights, Title Interest, Use, Possession, Property Claim and demand
 either at Law or in equity of him the said Daniel Marsh of, in, & out of the
