Bonus Norton, son of Reverend William & Lucy (Downing) Norton, in 1691 married Mary Goodhue, born in 1664 in Ipswich, MA, died 20 Apr 1719, in Hampton, NH. Mary, daughter of Deacon Joseph & Sarah (Wipple) Goodhue. Together Bonus & Mary had nine children. William (m. Elizabeth Cotton then, Esther Dearborn Lovering), Mary (m. Daniel Moody), Joseph (m. Abigail Gove), Sarah (m. Thomas Waite), Samuel, John (m.Rebecca Wilson), Elizabeth (m. Thomas Jenness, then Benjamin Swett), Lucy (m. John Jenness), and Anne (m. Jonathan Towle) Norton. Bonus took the "Oath of Fidelity" in 1678. Bonus Norton's estate was administered on 04 June 1718 in Hampton, NH. He was buried in what was also known as the Quaker Cemetery.






