Sixthly. To my Son Samuel I give & bequeath one third
part of my Home lot on which I now dwell, to be taken
from the South side of the same, to have & to hold to him the
said Samuel his heirs & assigns forever —

Seventhly. To my Son Moses Samuel I give & bequeath
as a compensation for the support of myself & my wife the
sum of fifty Dollars per annum reckoning from the first
day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred six to the term of my decease —

Eighthly. To my Son Moses Samuel I give & bequeath
two third parts of all the rest residue of my estate both
real & personal (after payment of my just debts & funeral
charges) to have & to hold to them the said Moses & Samuel
their heirs & assigns forever in equal shares —

Ninthly. The remaining one third part of the said res-
idue of my estate I direct to be as follows, viz. — The said
third part being divided into nine equal parts, I give
& bequeath four of the said nine parts to Moses Kellogg
& Charles Austin Kellogg sons of my Son Benjamin Kellogg
late of Haddam aforesaid deceased to have & to hold the said
four parts to them the said Moses & Charles Austin their
heirs & assigns forever in equal shares — And the remaining
five of the said nine parts I give & bequeath to the five Daugh-
ters of the said Benjamin — viz. — Mary Warner the wife of
Seth Warner of Sunderland, Cornelia Kellogg, Elizabeth
Kellogg, Martha Kellogg & Angelina Kellogg to have
& to hold the said five parts to them the said Mary, Corne-
lia, Elizabeth, Martha & Angelina their heirs & assigns
forever in equal shares —

Lastly. I the said Moses Kellogg (proving all for
with by me made) do hereby constitute & appoint
aforesaid Son Samuel & Roswell the Son of my said
Moses to be the Executors of this my last will & testament
