WILL OF CHRISTIAN MEIBERGER SR, STRASBURG, VIRGINIA, BOOK B, PAGE 350 June 28, 1787

In the name of God Amen, I Christian Neiberger Sr, of the Town of Strasburg Shenendoah County and State of Virginia, being at present weak in body but of sound mind and Disposing memory Thanks be to God for the same, do think proper to make this my Last will & Testament which I do in the following manner, and in the first place I do order and direct that all my just debts together with the funeral expenses be paid and discharged by my Executor as soon as convenient after my decease, and first I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Ann Mary all my personal Estate of all and singular of which I am possesses at the day of my decease her proper use and behoof during her Natural life, and I do give dovise and bequeath unto my well beloved son Christian Neiberger all of them two half sore Inlotte situate and lying in said town of Strasburg & County aforesaid together with all appartanences therete belonging to him and his heids and assigns forever. Provided that my said son Christian Neiberger or his executors and administrators shall assist help and provide for her during her natural life his said mother my said wife Ann Mary and also help to bring up my youngest child Blizabeth untill 10 arrives at the age of 10 years and to give her schooling if she live that long, and whereas I have considered the services of my beloved son Jacob Heiberger I do give and bequeath unto him the sum of ten pounds of good and lawful money of Virginia to be paid by my son Christian in five years after my

decease and I do order and direct that my two youngest sons, John and Christopher be put to some suitable trade for them until they arri " their full age of Twenty One Years Each and I de give and bequeath to my daughter Catharine the wife of Alexander Hite her bedatead "Chest & spinning wheel & heifemin his or her pessession also give unte my daughter Margaret her Bestead and I do order and direct that my said son Christian shal give unto my two youngest daughters Magdeline and Hissb each of them the same as their older Sisters have got. That is to say a bedatead a chest & spinning wheel each at their coming to the ful age of Twenty one years also a heifer and as many Pounds of feathers as anyof the others received and I do further order and direct that if my said wife Arm Mary should die within a short period of time them my said son Christian shall pay unto Each of his two younger brothers John and Christepher each at their coming of full age of twenty one years the full sum of five pounds of good and lawful money of Virginia and lastly it is by will and desire that my Estate shall not be appraised and no security demanded for the same in consideration of the Administration ship and last will and Testament, to which I have constituted & appointed my loving son Christian Neiberger sole Executor to this my Last will and Testament in Witness whereaf I have hereunte set my hand and seal this Seventh day of December one thousand Seven hundred and Fighty Five.
