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 Mary Gardner's Will } Know all men by these presents that I Mary Gardner, of Pittston Township, in the County of Luzerne and State of Pennsylvania, being of sound disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament: First, I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Martha Knapp, three feather beds, four blankets, two white, and two check, four pair of sheets, four pair of pillow cases, one red and white coverlid, six bed quilts, one large blue chest, two trunks with their contents, six Silver Tea Spoons, one Butcher Knife, one large Mirror, one clock, one large Bible, and Four hundred Dollars in cash. Second I give and bequeath to my Son Joseph Gardner one Desk and One hundred Dollars in cash. Third, I give and bequeath to Mary Funnell twenty five Dollars in lieu of a legacy left her, by my late husband which legacy has never been paid her. Fourth, I give and bequeath to my two Grand children Ziba Knapp and Mary Knapp, each Eighty Dollars. Fifth, I give and bequeath to each of the five daughters of my son Joseph Gardner five Dollars a piece. Sixth, I require of my Executors to procure and set five pair of Tomb Stones, one pair for Elizabeth Gardner, one do. for John Gardner, one do. for Mary Harding, one do. Harry Gardner, and one pair for myself, the price and quality of said Stones to be left to the discretion of my Executors. Seventh, I give and bequeath to Catharine Polen out of regard to her kindness to me the sum of thirty Dollars. And further my Will is that all the property that I shall die possessed of not specially devised as aforesaid shall be sold by my Executors to the best advantage they can, and the money arising from such sale, after my just debts and funeral expenses are paid, to be applied to the aforesaid legacies, and in case there should be a surplus after paying such expenses and legacies, such surplus to go to my Grand daughter Martha Knapp, and if there should be deficiency such deficiency to be supplied from the legacy of four hundred Dollars left to the said Martha as aforesaid. And whereas I have full confidence in Peter Polen and Nathaniel Duthill I ordain and appoint them Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
