I found this badly deteriorated grave in the Spencer Cemetery at Plymouth, NH, next to that of Bridget Snow, 1700-1773. I could make out only the name, and that only with great difficulty. Possibly he is the Amos Phillips about whom I found this information at the Plymouth Historical Society web site(http://www.plymouthnhhistoricalsociety.org/Obits/1800_to_1819_obituaries.htm):

"PHILLIPS, AMOS, died 10/15/1801. He was the son of Seth, and was born 10/27/1719. He was one of the grantees of Plymouth and moved here, locating at Lower Intervale, in 1767 from Dunstable, where he lived for the previous 20 years. In 1746 he married Abigail Dodge from Massachusetts. She died seven years after Amos. They had 11 children during their marriage."

From the same source: "PHILLIPS, ABIGAIL (DODGE), the widow of Amos Phillips, died 2/15/1808. She was the daughter of Noah and Margaret (Crockett) Dodge, and the mother of 11 children during her marriage to Amos." She is probably buried here as well, but I find no record.
