He was taxed as a freeman (single man) at Conestoga Township, Lancaster County in 1757. On 13 February 1763 he sold his 153 acres on Pequea Creek next to John Kagey in Lancaster County to Henry Bowers. On 24 April 1764 he sold 50 acres in Conestoga Township to Jacob Harnish. He was of Conestoga Township, Lancaster County when he bought land in Shrewsbury Township, York County on 31 September 1763 from Nicklaus Bieri. He bought land in Manchester Township, York County on 24 July 1767 from Israel Morris and he was living there when he and his wife Barbara sold it to Daniel Beitler of Hellam Township, on 17 May 1775. He was taxed at Shenandoah County, Virginia in 1787 with Tobias Blaser in his household. (Emigrants, etc.)
