* Biography

Herman Atwood immigrated to New England in 1641 as an employee of Thomas Buttolph. He was from Sanderstead, Surrey. [1] Samuel Worthen stated that he was a son of Deacon John and Mary L. (Smith) Atwood; he did not describe his basis for this information. [2]

He was admitted to the Church in Boston on 24 February 1644, and that same year was a member of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company. [1][2]

He was married to Ann Copp in Boston, Massachusetts, on 11 August 1646. [3] Two children were born to their marriage: John and Sarah Atwood. [1][4][5]

Hermon Atwood died in Boston before 13 October 1651, when inventory of his estate was taken and valued at 34 pounds, 3 shillings. The estate was proved on 19 November 1651; administration was granted to Ann Atwood, wife of the deceased, on behalf of herself and two children. [6]
