Came to Jefferson County in 1807, via Kentucky on August 13, 1812 Jeffersonville Land Office, James Blankenship, assignee of Isaiah Blankenship, obtained a patent for 160 acres in the southeast guarter section 32, In what is now Republican Township, A patent deed was made for this land in Jefferson.County Indiana on August 13, 1842 and recorded on Nov 8, 1843. James and Alice deeded the land to their son James Jr on Aug 13, 1845 (same day) Jas Sr wrote his will, However out of consideration and affection for his parents James Jr agreed to lease 41 acres of land to his parents durning their lifetime. This lease agreement included the dwelling house, Orchard, garden, a field on the west side of the creek, a pasture field on the north ajoining a small tract of ground occupied by Ambrose White. Timber was to be furnished from James Jr's other lands and he was to keep up the fences and provide a sufficiency of firewood. James Blankenship Sr died shortly afterwards on April 23, 1848, He was laid to rest on the Blankenship farm on a hilltop on the westside of Little Creek, Near by rested his grand daughter Mary Fidelia Tull, who died on March 7, 1843 and his daughter Lucretia Tull who died on May 31, 1846. On Jan 17, 1887 James Blankenship Jr sold 135 acres of the southeast quarter of Section 32 to Archibald Guthrie. The sale excluded so much of said tract as had been laid out in town lots in the town of Kent. It also excluded an acre for the present Public graveyard, and one acre for a family graveyard. The public graveyard mentioned in this deed was part of the present day Kent Cemetery and the family graveyard was the Blankenship Cemetery this appeares to be when the land surrounding the cemetery was sold out of the Blankenship Family. The Blankenships father and then the son had owned this land for 75 years.
