The Church of the Walpeck Congregation: A Dutch Reformed Church, and many of the Kermer family were there from 1741 on. The marriage records are lost, and many of the baptismal records as well. But they did have a record of Evje's baptism 24 May 1752. The records stop for John and Christina at 1852, with the exception of a child being named for John Drake in 1811 by William and Christiana (Mires) Courtright. I am still researching a birth for William.

Note: Supposedly, William was baptized 31 Aug 1760 in Smithfield, Northampton, Pennsylvania. I have not seen proof of this. It may have been another William. If John truly waited 2 years to baptize him, it would have been a second baptism into the church at New Jersey.

About Jesamine:

Elba was still surrounded by rough territory and Jesamine was appointed as Ensign (communications officer) before the War of 1812. While engaged in the war [1813 - 1814] his infantry was attached to Churchill's Regiment as Corporal. Staying with the military after the war, he was appointed Lieutenant in 1817.

He must have been a very civic minded person attracted to 'rough territory' in need of growth. He was Constable for Elba, Genesse, New York in 1820; poss in Chautauqua County, New York, by 1830; in *Genesee, New York by 1840; in Iowa by 1850; but had migrated to his son Homer's family in Wisconsin by 1860.

Notes: Jesamine Drake appeared on the census in 1820 at Elba, Genesee Co., New York, as Jeremiah Drake, with a household of 3 males under 10, 1 male 10-16, 1 male 26-45, 1 female under 10, 1 female 16-25, 2 persons engaged in agriculture. His record at the cemetery also states his name as Jeremiah.


