- Louis S. Drake, in *Jesayas Jansze Drake of New Netherlands, 1648-after 1720?* (1967), a descendant of William Drake and Eunice Holmes (sic) states that William is a descendant of John Drake (of Jamaica, L.I. and Goshen, N.Y.) and his wife Magdalena Brouwer (which in itself is incorrect) and John Drake's parents, Josias Drats and Aeltje Brouwer. However, no evidence has been found to support a descent for this William Drake from Josias Drats through any line.
