She was the wife of Lewis. She died on October 21st, 1864 at the age of 45 years-9 months-1 day old. Louisa Adams first married Philip H. Berrier July 27, 1839. Philip H. Berrier came to Rochester ca. 1834 and helped to build the second Courthouse and first frame dwelling in Rochester. He is said to have died ca. 1842. However, letters of Adm for the P.H. Berrier Estate, were filed by R.E. Adams and P. Berrier January --, 1849; also, two children were born after 1842. Names of only three of the five children of Philip H. and Louisa (Adams) Berrier are known: Elizabeth b.ca.1841 Ind; Samuel b.ca.1843 Ind; Robt. Newton, b. May 7, 1845 at Rochester, m. Frances Luella Beery 1873. Louisa (Adams) Berrier next married Lewis Bailey May 15, 1853. Lewis Bailey and his first wife Eve were residents of Union Twp in 1850 with five children. Eve was gone from his family sometime between 1848 and 1853, and Louisa and Lewis Bailey were residents of Rochester city in 1860 with four of his children and three of Louisa's Berrier children. After the death of Lewis Bailey's second wife, Louisa, he married
