TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME—Greeting:

Know Ye, That in consideration of an entry made in the Surveyor's Office of the tenth
District, of No. 1110, dated the 9th day of March 1812, founded on a warrant of
No. 2052, issued by John Armstrong Esq; to David Stead for one thousand and
eighty acres of land dated the 30th day of December 1785 twenty five acres of which
are assigned to Adam Blaizier the entries there are granted by the said State of
Tennessee unto the said Adam Blaizier and his heirs a certain tract or parcel of
land containing twenty five acres lying in the County of Cocke in said district
on the north branch of clear creek beginning at a stake at the end of the first line of a
tract of land patented in the name of David Walker hence south sixty four degrees
east forty poles with the same leap each on a course of a southerly survey south
eighty east sixty four poles owing a branch to a stake on a line of William
Yates land south sixty eight and a half poles east seventy six poles with the same
to a stake north eighty and a half east forty seven poles to a stake on Yates
line north fifty five east thirty two poles to the beginning

Surveyed the 9th day of December 1811,

with its appurtenances, to have and to hold the said Tract or Parcel of Land, with its appurtenances, to the said

Adam Blaizier and his heirs and assigns forever.

In Witness Whereof, William Carroll Governor of the said State of Tennessee, has hereunto set his hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed at Nashville, on the 11th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three and of American Independence the fifty eighth.
