 marry to another man I give to her one bed  
 and bedding also I give to my elder son David  
 Young the sum of sixteen for his death  
 right also I let David Young my son on two  
 hundred acres of land adjoining Schambra-  
 bing which I give to him after my wife's  
 marriage or decease also the rest of my lands  
 that I have I give all and singular to  
 my Son John Young and David Young  
 to have and to hold forever also I give to them

I<sup>do</sup> that John Miami Egg! shall by an  
 agreement made between him and me  
 pay Mr. Baugher and Mr. Livingston for  
 this six hundred acres of land that I pur-  
 chased of them here in Flaggstown and  
 what is not done then my executors  
 may settle my debts that I have in  
 Montgomery County or as much of them  
 as we'll pay for those lands here in Flagg-  
 stown and if it may be after my debts have  
 is paid for and their shall remain any  
 lands or money I will that it be divided  
 between my Sons David and John and  
 Jacob I will that my Horses and Cattle  
 be kept together on the farm until  
 Elizabeth my wife also my farming tools  
 be kept together on the farm as long as  
 Elizabeth my wife shall remain my widow  
 or if my wife and sons John and Jacob  
 shall agree to divide horses and cattle then  
 they can divide them ethen and Jacob  
 shall have the one of my farming tools  
 as well as my wife I will that my son  
 David shall make to John and Jacob one  
 half of a wheel plow and share his plow  
 one half and I do make and ordain  
 that Wolf of his half plow of the execu-  
 tor of this my last will and Testament  
 and I do hereby utterly disallow recoupe  
 and disannul all and every other  
 former testaments, wills, legacies be-  
 givens and executors by me in any  
 wise before named wills and legacies.
