firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated this
19th day of May 1806 —

bound Edward Loughtlin hath this day obtained a license for
his marriage with Miss Cornith — of this County Now if there
shall not hereafter appear any lawful Cause to obstruct
the Marriage then this Obligation to be Void else to remain
in full force.
