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In the Name of God Amen this twenty third day of August
in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred & forty
two John Hutchinson of Denfer in the County of Derby, Keeper,
being in Imperfect health of Body, but of sound Understanding and
Memory, praised be God, do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testam. in manner following: And first I commend my Soul to God
trusting that by his Mercy & thro' the Merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ
I shall inherit Eternal Life, and my Body I commit to the Earth to be
decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors here after named.
And as concerning my Temporall Estate, both real and Personall
I give, devise and dispose thereof in manner following And first
I do order & appoint that my Dear Wife Elizabeth Hutchinson shall
peaceably & quietly have, hold and enjoy all that my Messuages and
Tenam. witho^y Rest adjoining thereto lying or being in Litten Dale
and also my other lands lying or being at Litten, all in the Parish of
Thoswell County afore said in the tenure of James Osfield during
her natural Life, and after my said Wifes Decease I give and bequeath
the said house witho^y lands above mentioned unto my son John

Hutchinson his Heirs and Assigns for ever, the paying unto his two
Brothers Anthony and Daniel Hutchinson each and either of them y^e
Sum of Ten Pounds Sterling, a piece and I also give unto my son
Anthony Hutchinson y^e Sum of Twenty pounds Sterling, Also I give
Twenty pennes unto my son Daniel Hutchinson Also unto my three
sons Children namely, Robert Thomas Jane and Dorothy Hutchinson
I give each and every one of them y^e Sum of Thirty pounds Sterling
All these respective Sums to be paid to my above mentioned Sons &
Daughters as they shall attain to the age of twenty one years & not
before, except any of said Sons shall have occasion for any part of
the portion assigned him to put him out apprentice, which I leave
to the Discretion of my Executors and Trustees; and also my son John
shall not be obliged to pay unto his two brothers Anthony and Daniel
each of them the Ten pounds before said, before he shall peaceably
enjoy y^e Estate above mentioned. And I do appoint my Brothers Robert
and Thomas to all my Children. If any of my Children, that is to say
Daniel, Robert, Thomas, Jane or Dorothy shall die before they
attain to y^e Age of twenty one years their Portion to be divided
among the surviving Children (John excepted) and I do appoint

And I do hereby appoint that my Wife shall enjoy all my personal Estate untill my Children shall each attain unto the Age of Twenty one Years. As above mentioned. If she continue unmarried, but if she my said Wife shall happen to Marry after my Decease, then I do hereby appoint her only five hundred of my said personal Estate, And also immediately after her Marriage my said Trustee shall have power to seize & take possession of my Real Estate for the Use of my said Son John Hutchinson, And my Will & Desire is that my Executrix or Trustee shall not be charged with or accountable for any Loss that shall happen in the management of my Estate. She or He acting according to the best of their Discretion. And of this my last Will and Testament, I do hereby constitute and appoint, My dear Wife Elizabeth Hutchinson Sole Executrix & do hereby revoke all former Wills by me heretofore made. And publish this as my last Will and Testament.
