Devised to gr.-son Samuel, the house I live in, shop and barn; 1 acre Molton pt. next Solomon Phipps, with highway 1 pole wide run. through other 2 acre lot; 1 common; interest in nearest wood-lot. To Caleb, house I built for him, with what his gr.-father left him; 1 common; 1 hay-lot in Dirty marsh; 1 acre Molton pt., with what is more than I give son Waters. To S. Waters, house John Poore lives in, and yard 24 by 12 next John Knight; land between John Whitman's shop and house; ¼ wood-lot near Reading. To N. Rand, part of house he did not pay me for. To dau. Hannah Barrett, house she lives in; 2 acres Molton pt. next Stilson. The nearest wood-lot given among all the chn.

INVENTORY: Little house, great house, 6 acres upland, 2 acres Molton pt., Dirty marsh, 2 commons, 22 acres woods, further wood-lots; 1681. See Perkins.

HIS ESTATE granted 2½ cow commons, 1681. His heirs granted 8¼ acres—n w, range; n e, by Dean's heirs and T. Danforth; s e, range; s w, Menotomy road; 1685.
