Leave granted James PEEBLES to build a grist mill on his land. William BOWYER, Gent. was duly qualified as an attorney according to Law and admitted to his practice in this Court. Alexander MONTGOMERY took the usual oaths of supporting the Constitution of the U.S. and of the State of Va. and having produced a license under the hands and seals of three of the Judges of the Gen'l. Court of this State is admitted to practice in this Court.

At a court held for the county of Greenbrier July 1811. David DIVEN bound to keep the peace toward Sarah DIVEN his wife under bond to George Wm. SMITH Esq. Lieutenant Governor of Va. (Now exercising the office of Governor) Lemuel RUCKER and Ephraim RUCKER, securities.

A letter of Attorney from Peter DEW to Samuel DEW, presented in Ct. and proved by David KEAN, Wm. SMITH. A deed from the trustees of Lewisburg to George WILFORD was further acknowledged by Thomas EDGAR and ordered recorded. The Commonwealth vs. Thos. HENNING an indictment for a breach of the peace.
