## Records that Relate to Thomas Stone Descendants

1693 , Maryland

The following records shed light on Barbara Stone, Daughter of Thomas Stone, and her family, to include husband Dennis Garrett (1650-1691), grandson Dennis Garrett Cole (1693-1773). They establish the fact that Barbara Stone married Dennis Garrett In August of 1712, Barbara conveyed property to her children Thomas and Jane Broad and to her grandson, Dennis Garrett Cole. She also mentioned "threat that her son Thomas was not to marry Grace Ramsey or to go away".

September 1730, Barbara and her daughter Frances (Garrett) Haile conveyed 100 acres "Long Island Point" to Nicholas Haile.

Barbara's will is dated 19 January 1732 to 6 August 1733, Baltimore County, MD

The administration bond was posted by Edward Cox, Thomas Broad and William Green.

Her will mentions her granddaughter Sarah (Cole) Gorsuch, wife of Charles Gorsuch; her son Thomas Broad and his wife Ann (Hawkins) Broad; her daughter Frances (Garrett) Haile; her granddaughter Barbara Broad who married James Demmitt.

TO ALL CHRISTIAN PEOPLE TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS:

I, Thomas Stone, for and in consideration of the tender love and affection which I, Thomas Stone, have to Dennis Garrett, deceased, for and in consideration of the same love and affection which I have for his children, lawfully begotten of the body of Barbary Garrett, his wife, and by these presents do freely give, grant, assign and make over and by these presents I do give, grant, assign and make over to Barbary Garrett all that tract or parcel of land purchased by the said Dennis Garrett and the said Thomas Stone called Long Island Point and whereupon the said Dennis Garrett lived and enjoyed his life time, together with all buildings, orchards, fences and all the appurtenances, I do hereby assign over from me and my heirs, assigns, etc., to the heirs of the said Dennis Garrett (after the said Barbary deceases) and the assigns forever and by their presence in testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this 1st day of March 1693.
