1. THOMAS1 DAY, SR. was born Abt. 1740 in Maryland or Virginia (Possibly Bedford, Virginia and died Bet. 1830 - 1840. He married (1) ANN. She died Unknown. He married (2) ELIZABETH MOODY July 25, 1785 in Bedford County, Virginia, daughter of THOMAS MOODY and SARAH ANN. She was born Abt. 1765, and died Bet. 1810 - 1820. Notes for THOMAS DAY, SR.: Thomas died between 1830-1840 on Joe's Fork, Buffalo Cove, Wilkes County (now present-day Caldwell), North Carolina. There is a connection between Thomas Day and the Wright family as the names are often associated together. Thomas Day sold land to Joseph Wright. On one deed Thomas Day is mistakenly identified as Thomas Wright. More About THOMAS DAY, SR.: Fact 1 (2): married two times More About ANN: Fact 1 (2): Her Maiden name is not known. 2. THOMAS2 DAY, JR. (THOMAS1) was born Abt. 1770 in Lived in Burke County, North Carolina, and died Unknown. He married ANN Abt. 1795. She died 1844.

Notes for THOMAS DAY, JR.:

He migrated to Louisiana about 1801 or 1802 while it was still a French possession. He died between 1817 and 1820 in St. Helena Parish. Ten children lived to maturity with the order of age uncertain.

Notes for WILLIAM DAY:

He followed his brother, Thomas , to Louisiana about 1803, the year when President Thomas Jefferson purchased the vast Louisiana from the France Emperor, Neopolin I. He married the second time in Louisiana.

4. NANCY2 DAY (THOMAS1) was born Abt. 1774 in Virginia, and died Unknown. She married EDM Abt. 1795 in Virginia. He was born Abt. 1764 in Virginia, and died Unknown.

Notes for NANCY DAY: Her and Edmund were in Burke County, North Carolina, where at least 5 of their children were born; they were in Tennessee in 1810, and apparently in Virginia in 1818, but by 1819 they had settled on Dugger's Fork of Elk Creek in Wilkes County. He married (2) MARY HOLDER September 22, 1825 in Wilkes County, NC. She died Unknown. Notes for HUGH DAY: He is not found in 1810 or 1820 census in North Carolina. He may have followed his brothers to Louisiana. All the known children are to be from the second marriage.
