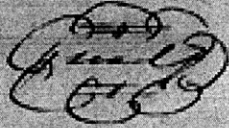

 one thousand eight hundred. Between John May of the County of Effete and
 State of North Carolina of the one part & Abraham May of the County of Effete
 of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John May for his consideration
 of the sum of fifty thousand dollars to him in hand paid by the said Abraham May
 the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged, hath Granted Bargained sold by these
 presents unto the said Abraham May all every Abolition unto the said May one certain
 tract or parcel of Land lying being in the County of Effete in the State
 of North Carolina beginning on George Robinson's corner on a black Oak
 thence North with the Davis line 18 poles to a white Oak thence with a beech
 line 110 poles to a peach tree his corner, thence with a beech line to the said Oak
 it is a maple thence up the said Oak to the said Robinson line thence with his line
 to the fork station, containing fifty acres be the same more or less, (copy)
