firmly by these presents Sealed with our  
Seals and dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February  
in the year 1806

The condition of the above obligation is such,  
that whereas the above bound Prestwood Smith  
hath this day prayed and obtained a li-  
cence to be joined in marriage to Sarah Brap-  
field of this County Now if there is no  
awful cause to obstruct the marriage for  
which the licence was granted, then the above  
obligation to be void otherwise to be and re-  
main in full force and virtue.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above bound Reuben Brappfield hath this day prayed & obtained a license for William Farher to be joined in marriage to Sarah Brappfield of the County aforesaid Now if there is no lawful cause to obstruct the marriage for which the license was granted Then the above obligation to be void otherwise to be remain in full force and virtue.
